Updates to the Proposed Water Conservation Regulations
“Making Conservation a California Way of Life.”

Dear ACC-OC Members,

Making Conservation a California Way of Life is a new regulatory framework proposed by the California State Water Resources Control Board that will establish individualized efficiency goals for each Urban Retail Water Supplier.

On March 12, 2024, the Board posted New Language for the proposed regulations.

The window for public comment is 15 days and will run through March 27, 2024. A State Water Board workshop will be held on March 20th.
